SESSION SNEAK PEAK...

"WHO DO YOU WALK WITH?"

Each of EMBRACE's sessions has what we call a "springboard" that sets the stage for how the session will unfold. We never know how the horse activity will impact our participants, or what kind of insights our participants will receive, but it's always a beautiful and God-glorifying experience.

Primary Scripture:

"Become wise by walking with the wise. Hang out with fools and watch your life fall to pieces."

- Proverbs 13:20

Horse Activity:

Part 1: Start out with two riders and leaders per horse. One participant mounts the horse bareback, then tries to help the other person onto the horse.

Next have the person on the ground try to pull the person on the horse off the horse, rider cannot hold on to any tack to aid staying on. Once the rider is off switch positions and do it again.

Part 2: Do the same activity, but this time give the participants counsel and advice as to an easier way to get on the horse. Provide assistance in tools, a leg up, etc.

After both participants are mounted, have one get down and try to pull the other off. This time, the session leaders can defend the rider and help her stay on the horse.

Note to the session leaders: be prepared to laugh!

We ask the participants: was it easier to pull someone up, or pull them down? What about the second time around when you had help getting up, and had someone defending you so you couldn't get pulled down?

It's always easier to pull people down, but when we surrender our lives to Jesus Christ, even when the world tries to pull us down, we have a defender in the Holy Spirit and in our fellow believers to help us stay in the saddle.
