Genesis 1:25-28 (NLT)

God made all sorts of wild animals, livestock, and small animals, each able to produce offspring of the same kind. And God saw that it was good. The God said, "Let us make human beings in our image, to be like us. They will reign (rule) over the fish in sea, the birds in the ski, the livestock, all the wild animals on the earth, and the small animals that scurry along the ground."

Horse Activity

What is Creation? What is Evolution?

Set up 2 obstacle courses. Each will have several poles and cones.

Course 1 will have order and a pattern will be give and explained to the rider. The rider executes the patter as many times as necessary to ride it as correctly as possible. This course represents God's creation. There is order and a plan. There is failure and success but you are there to coach and help as God is for us.

Course 2 will have no order... Cones will be in the middle in a heap! Leader will ask the rider if they would like to see if tossing the cones would form a pattern? The rider will be asked to wait and see if the cones become a course with a patter and directions. This course represents evolution. The world was formed by one big bang and things just began to form somehow with no order or plan.
